ETIQUETTE - MEMBERS

Players are requested to observe the following points to ensure that the game is played in its true spirit.

1. No one should move, talk or stand close to, or directly behind the ball or the hole when the player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
2. No player shall play until the players in front are out of range.
3. When a ball is lost and the search is continuing, call oncoming players through. Should the ball be found, or declared lost before the following players catch up, play may be continued; but only with the signified approval of the following players.
4. A player or players who fall more than one fairway behind proceeding players shall call following players through. Failure to observe this rule will incur a penalty of two strokes (Rule 6.7)
5. Walk briskly between shots; if possible always proceed to your own ball in play. Plan your next shot on the way to where your ball lies. Pick up your ball when your strokes in Stableford are expended.
6. When a play of a hole has been completed, players should immediately leave the putting green.
7. Players should move to the next Tee before marking cards.
8. If a player is in doubt of the location of his ball following a shot he/she should play a provisional ball before going forward to search.
9. Repair divots, smooth out bunkers and repair plug Marks on greens. Sand buckets must be carried at all times to repair divots. Rakes are to be left in bunkers, parallel with fairways.
10. Competition players have priority on the course.
11. Players must be properly dressed at all times, on the Course and in the Clubhouse (see Standard of Dress, Course and Clubhouse).
12. The players on the lowest handicap in each match or competition automatically become Captain of the match. It becomes his/ her responsibility to ensure that the points mentioned above are strictly observed.
13. Players must give right of way to grounds staff carrying out their duties.

SLOW PLAY

The following are suggested to reduce slow play which destroys the pleasure of golf:

1. Keep up with players in front. If you are falling behind the group ahead your group is probably playing too slowly.
2. At the tee, the honour should be ignored if a player is not ready to play. Through the green if there is no danger to others a player should play on reaching their ball.
3. In Stableford events, players should pick up their ball when they are unable to score a point on a hole.
4. During play, only a player, the partner and caddies should search for a ball. If others in the group join the search, the following group of players should be called through.
5. When a group is called through the original group should not continue their play until these players are out of range.
6. When the result of a hole has been determined, players should immediately leave the green and should not unduly delay play by retrying their putts or practice chipping.
7. After completing 9 holes a stop to purchase drinks or food is limited to 6 minutes.
8. It is the responsibility of the lowest Marker in any match to see that the above points are observed.

The Match Committee considers that a round of 18 holes at Gladstone should take no longer than 4 hours 20 minutes.

Saturday Timesheets for members' competitions are available online 2 weeks in advance, most other events are available online 1 week in advance.

No names should be added to the booking sheet without the member being aware of the booking.

No member shall change any other member's time of play on the time sheet unless authorised by such member.

Members of a recognised golf club can nominate for play in regular club competitions but may be asked to produce evidence of their membership and their current handicap. They are not eligible to win Monthly Medals and other major events.

A member who is nominated for an event and cannot play must notify the starter as early as possible. Repeated failure to do this will result in committee action with temporary suspension from competition play being a possible outcome.

G.P.S. DEVICES

The use of these devices is allowed on our golf course for all Gladstone Golf Club approved events.

MOBILE PHONES

Although Gladstone Golf Club does not currently apply a penalty for use of mobile phones on the course, the Match Committee asks all players to respect the etiquette of the game with their use of mobile phones. Generally players should restrict the use of mobile phones during competition events to emergency use only and have them set to silent mode so as to not distract other golfers.

MOTORISED GOLF CARTS

It is general golf course policy that motorised carts are permitted on the course whenever the course is open for play. However, on some occasions, it may be necessary to temporarily restrict the use of motorised carts. Privately owned Carts require registration from YGL at a charge of \$5 per day or \$150 annually.

Carts driven on the course must have insurance cover for third party liability.

Carts should be kept off all teeing areas and from the surrounds at least 10m from the greens. All players are required to observe the signs indicating restricted areas for motorised carts.

GOLF COMPETITIONS AND HOW THEY ARE PLAYED

The following notes are intended to assist in the general concept of how various competitions are played. They should be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf.

Stroke (Medal)

The number of strokes a player takes to complete each hole is recorded, totalled and the player's full handicap deducted. The player who completes the stipulated round in the fewest nett strokes is the winner. Usually a gross winner is also determined.

Stableford

Points are awarded for the net result at each hole. For example, a net 1 over par = 1 point, a net par = 2 points, a birdie = 3 points, an eagle = 4 points etc. The net score is the gross score on the hole minus any handicap shots the player receives on that hole. When no points are scored the player does not need to record the number of shots played on that hole.

Four-Ball Stableford

Called a Four ball although played by teams of two players. At the completion of the hole, the player recording the highest number of points has his/her score entered on the card. If both players score equally on the hole, the score of the player who completed the hole first is recorded. There is no need to record both scores since only the best score is required. A Medley Four ball allows partners to be men or women in any combination. A Mixed Four ball means one partner must be a woman and the other a man.

Mixed Four Ball Par or Stableford

These games are played as previously described except that a man is paired with a woman. Ladies use their own tees, score cards and local rules.

Foursomes

Two players play as partners and use one ball. The partners strike off alternately from the tee and thereafter strike the ball alternately during the play at each hole. Scoring is as per a stroke round and half of the partners' aggregate handicap is deducted from the total.

Par

Players need to allocate full handicap strokes to each hole, as explained for individual Stableford competition. Once players mentally determine their own par for each hole, the individual par competition challenges them to beat their own par. If players do exceed their par, they score a '+' (plus) for the hole. If players equal their own 'o'. If par is not achieved a '-' (minus) sign is recorded. At the end of the round the plus and minus signs are added, and the net result written in as many 'Up', 'down' or 'halved'.

Tiger Stableford (2 Person Stableford Multiplier)

Using Stableford scoring after completion of the hole, each 'individual' score for the hole is recorded and the Stableford points are calculated and also recorded. Both Stableford points for the hole are multiplied and the resulting score is recorded for the team.

(i.e. $2 \times 0 = 0$, $2 \times 1 = 2$ etc.)

Flag Completion (Full Handicap)

The score taken on each hole is entered on a score card as in a stroke round. When a player has completed a number of strokes equal to par of the course (as shown on the score card) plus their handicap, they will have finished the round. The first player to start in the competition will carry the flag and place it on the spot where their ball lay at the finish of their round. If the ball is in the rough the flag can be placed at the side of the fairway not nearer the hole. If the subsequent player has not finished the round when they reach the flag, they carry it with them and places it at the end of their strokes. The winner is the player who carries the flag the longest distance from the first tee and it normally happens that the final position is somewhere beyond the 18th green

Mixed Foursomes

Normal foursomes play except that a man is paired with a woman. Ladies use their own tees, score cards and local rules. The Committee will lay down as a condition of play whether the male or female is required to play from the first tee and in competitions consisting of more than one stipulated round, whether this order is to be preserved.

American Foursomes

Both players hit tee shots at each hole and then each plays a second shot with their partner's ball. One ball is then selected to continue normal foursomes play with the owner of this ball playing the third shot.

Canadian Foursomes

Both players hit tee shots at each hole and then nominate a ball with which to continue play as in a normal foursome. The partner plays the second stroke.

Ambrose Competition

A team stroke event played by groups of 2, 3 or 4 players. Each player hits a tee shot at each hole. The Captain then selects a ball and all players hit their next shot from that selected position. This pattern proceeds until the ball is holed. 2 players = 6 tee shots minimum per player 3 players = 4 tee shots minimum per player 4 players = 3 tee shots minimum per player.

Swingers – 4Ball Competitions

In the event of a person not having a partner in a 4Ball competition, a “swinger” may be used but MUST be the lowest Marker, who is only eligible to win with the original partner. This will not restrict the ability of the second partner to win the event.
